HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

There are many blocks of Shiraz on the three Elderton estate vineyards, some as old as 100 years. Some of the best parcels from each of these single sites (Nuriootpa, Greenock and Craneford) are blended to create what one can only describe as 'the perfect Barossa Shiraz'. The vines are grown in alluvial soils over limestone. The grapes, which are lovingly tended to by Peter Wild and his team, are mainly harvested at an optimum maturity of about 14 - 15 Baume.

The 2017 vintage was characterised by steady ripening of fruit across the Barossa.

From our vineyards we were able to get great fresh flavours particular to each site, with some tight just-ripe tannins behind to balance the fruit. We love the freshness that 2017 brings, and the elegance in the wines as a result.
