BROADBENT, DOURO, PORTUGAL



HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

REGION: Douro DOP

VINEYARD: Sourced from a variety of vineyards around the Douro region.

VINIFICATION: A blend of the top traditional red varieties of the Douro, harvested at optimal ripeness, with a focus on retaining balanced acidity. After being destemmed and crushed, the grapes went into stainless steel vats for fermentation. The wine was aged in oak for 12 months.

TASTING NOTES:

The wine is dark purple in color with an electric pink rim and slight staining of the tears. On the nose the wine has notes of ripe dark cherry, blackberry, black plum, orange rind with clove, blueberry preserve, violets, and forest notes. On the palate the wine has ripe and juicy dark fruit, it is full-bodied with substantial yet ripe tannin and a long finish.
