VITICULTURE/VINIFICATION

The main contributor in the wine is jokingly called Baby Duck, which is planted on granite soils on a gentle southern slope in the Polkadraai Hills ward in Stellenbosch. The second vineyard is planted in the Upper Blaauwklippen Valley on deep red soil.

The grapes are hand sorted and whole bunch pressed. Juice is very lightly settled with no additions to the raw juice, wild fermentation in old barrels of various sizes. Fermentation can last anywhere between three weeks and eleven months. The wine is kept on lees for around twelve months, then rested in tank on fine lees without fining for a further six months prior to bottling.

TASTING NOTES

Full-bodied and bright, lovely nose of pear juice, yellow fruit and blossoms, very fine palate, rich enough for the table, refreshing enough to be an apéritif.
