HISTORY

With its array of celebrated sun-soaked vineyards and captivating sights, the village of Pommard is surrounded by ageless, timeless beauty. At its heart, is Château de Pommard, a historic estate established in the early 18th century. The estate's walled Clos Marey-Monge is a 20 hectare monopole and a UNESCO heritage protected Burgundy climat, cultivating century-old vines. The distinct, but complementary, terroirs are farmed biodynamically, naturally fermented, and aged separately, creating wines of complexity, power and grace.

VINIFICATION and MATURATION

Originally planted as an English garden, the 1.29-hectare parcel situated at the foot of Château Micault was eventually transformed into a vineyard. Its vines grow on fine alluvial formations from the Avant-Dheune river and create a fruity Pinot Noir that's enjoyable young. Hand-harvested organic grapes, hand-sorted on a vibrating table. No whole bunch fermentation. Stainless steel fermentation vats by gravity flow. Long maceration over several weeks, minimal pumping-over and punching-down. French oak for aging on fine lees.

TASTING NOTES

"Light to medium deep ruby colour. Pure and perfumed with floral hints, wild raspberry, plum, gingerbread spice and mild oak underneath. Already a rounded texture with powdery tannin, rather supple with soft extraction with fluid red fruit and a long, finely spicy finish." - AL
