HISTORY

La Ferme du Mont in the Southern Rhône boasts a mosaic of vineyards, now owned and vinified by Stéphane Vedeau. Formerly a soccer player in Paris, Stéphane shifted to winemaking in 1989 and spent 15 years making award-winning wines in the Languedoc. Stéphane arrived in the Rhone Valley in 2000, creating La Ferme du Mont in the Southern Rhone where he continues to produce wines with freshness and soul using native yeasts and biodynamic methods.

VINIFICATION and MATURATION

Situated in the Saint Pierre district in the hollows of the hills and enclosed by trees, 4.5 hectares of Grenache and Mourvèdre offer a surprisingly complex variety of soils and exposure. Grapes are produced using a natural farming approach with a plant cover of rye, vesse and fava beans in the soil. La Ferme du Mont harvests low yields of sun-kissed fruit, but always balanced with a fresh structure and a triptych of mineral, ripe red fruit and forest spices. Vinified on a very slow kinetic during more than 7 weeks to integrate a homogeneous material in the middle of the palate and thus refine its innate greediness. Fermented in stainless steel and aged in conrete vats.

TASTING NOTES

This cuvée will delight wine lovers who are looking for frank fruit in a tasty bubble with a spicy finish.
