A.A.Badenhorst



The winery is part of the bio-diversity project. Alien vegetation control policies are practiced, and 300 indigenous trees are planted annually. All wines are naturally fermented. All Secateurs wines are vegan. IPW certified sustainable.

Alheit



All wines are naturally fermented, gluten free and additive free and the wine are also suitable for vegans. Alheit Vineyards is IPW certified and a firm member of Old Vines Project (OVP).

Auctioneer



The wine is suitable for vegans, additive free and the fruit is all sustainable.

Barboursville



All wines are vegan, vegetarian and gluten free. Barboursville employs sustainable practices but is not certified. Paxxito is naturally fermented.

Bava



The winery's philosophy is 'listen to nature and follow her lead'. Operates with eco-friendly agricultural methods in full compliance with the norms aimed at protecting the environment. Rooftop solar panels generate 150% of the electricity needed and 20 hectares of woods and meadows compensate for their emissions of CO2. In 2024, Bava vineyards obtained the SQNPI certification (National Quality System for Integrated Production) for grape production and their hazelnut orchards. Integrated production refers to an agricultural system where every production phase is coordinated to minimize its environmental impact, particularly regarding fertilization, soil management, weed control, and plant protection.



Beaumont



Beaumont is dedicated to enhancing the quality of the land they cultivate and the wines they create through several commitments. Firstly, they have obtained certification from the Integrated Production of Wine (IPW) Body in South Africa, guaranteeing that their wines are sustainably produced. Additionally, they employ natural fermentation techniques for their wines, including Hope Marguerite, New Baby, Mourvedre, and Vitruvian. As part of their conservation efforts, Beaumont has pledged 250 hectares of natural land for preservation. They actively participate in the Green Mountain Conservancy, a membership that reflects their commitment to environmental preservation. Furthermore, Beaumont proudly supports the Old Vines Project. All wines produced by Beaumont are both vegan and gluten-free, catering to specific dietary preferences and requirements. In terms of energy usage, the farm operates on solar power, aligning with their eco-friendly practices. Lastly, Beaumont has implemented an active policy of conserving their natural areas, aiming to safeguard the diverse fauna and flora inhabiting these regions.

Beeslaar



The winery is IPW certified sustainable.

Bindi Sergardi



Bindi Sergardi wines are produced with eco-friendly agricultural methods in full compliance with EU norms aimed at protecting the environment. In the cellar, wines are fermented naturally. In the vineyards, Bindi Sergardi does not irrigate, and uses only natural fertilizers. A hectare of land on the Marciabella estate has been dedicated to solar panels to help offset the winery's consumption of electricity. Although not yet officially certified, Bindi Sergardi is committed to operating thoroughly sustainable practices.

Broadbent Vinho Verde



Gluten free and vegetarian.

Broadbent Dão White



Suitable for vegetarians.

Broadbent Grüner Veltliner



Certified organic with the 2019 vintage. Farmed organically since 2017. The winery is certified sustainable. All wines are vegan, vegetarian and gluten free.

Broadbent Madeira



ISO 9001:2008 and BRC certified. In 2020/2021 the youngest Madeira's will be suitable for vegans and vegetarians. All wines are naturally fermented.

Capanna

All of Capanna's vineyards are certified organic and they use sustainable practices. No irrigation is used in the vineyards. The winery is internationally certified and recognized for using electricity solely from renewable sources.

Chateau de Pommard

Château de Pommard, located in Burgundy's Côte d'Or, excels in organic and biodynamic practices. Certified AB Organic in 2019 and Demeter Biodynamic in 2021, the estate avoids synthetic chemicals, uses sheep for natural composting, and employs draught horses for soil aeration. The Carabello-Baum family revitalized the vineyard, focusing on soil health and traditional methods. This ensures exceptional wine quality while maintaining environmental sustainability.

Chateau Musar

Chateau Musar's own vineyards have been certified organic by the CCPB since 2005. All wines are fermented naturally without the addition of yeasts, are produced with minimal intervention and are vegetarian, vegan and gluten free.

Chazalettes & Co.

All Vermouths are vegan-friendly and gluten free.

Cirillo

Cirillo is committed to the sustainability and continued health of all their vineyards, plus the greater environment. Marco Cirillo exercises this through the means of minimal intervention in the vineyards, emulating winter rains in drier seasons, plus implementing biodynamic and organic principals used to make all Cirillo Estate Wines.

De Martino

All wines are fermented using only wild yeasts, and are produced with minimal intervention in order to emphasize the sense of place and identity in the wines. 110 ha. of the 250 ha. family estate in Isla de Maipo is certified organic. The remaining vineyards are all farmed organically, but are not certified. De Martino is also certified sustainable with Wines of Chile. All wines are vegan, vegetarian, and gluten free.

De Wetshof

Enviro-scientific Farming for the Future Certified; Environmentally Friendly certified; IPW Certified: Farm and Cellar; ISO 9001/2008 certified (Quality management systems); ISO 22000/2005 certified (Food safety management systems); WWF Conservation Champion certified; Certified as Level Six Contributor to Black Economic Empowerment.

Domaine Devillard

Chateau de Chamirey, Domaine de la Ferte, Domaine de la Garenne, and Domaine des Perdrix practice sustainable vine growing, but do not hold any certifications.

Dyfi

Dyfi Gin is suitable for both vegans and vegetarians. The distillery is based in the UNESCO World Biosphere Reserve of the Dyfi Valley, and subscribes to its sustainability charter. Furthermore, at time of writing, Dyfi is the only distillery in the world to have received accreditation from the United Nations' Support the Goals 2030 program, which recognizes companies strict environmental policies.

Dr. Hermann

All wines are vegan, vegetarian, glutenfree & naturally fermented.

The Curator

Made by AA Badenhorst, The Curator is part of the bio-diversity project. Alien vegetation control policies are employed and 300 indigenous trees are planted annually.

Delaire Graff

All wines are vegan, vegetarian and gluten free.

Elderton Wines

Elderton was first certified carbon neutral in 2007. The Elderton winery and its Estate and Reserve wines are officially certified by the national Sustainable Winegrowing Australia program as of the 2022 vintage. All red wines are vegan, vegetarian and gluten free.

Georges Vernay

All wines are certified organic and naturally fermented.

Gusbourne

Gusbourne is dedicated to sustainable wine production and has received accreditation from Sustainable Wines of Great Britain for both their vineyards and winery. They source the majority of their produce locally, maintain 9.2 hectares of ancient woodland, and use 99% renewable energy. Their innovative practices include significant water conservation, biodiversity promotion with over 30 plant species and two bee hives in their vineyards, and achieving zero winery bottling waste. Gusbourne is a leader in environmental stewardship, committed to low-intervention farming and continuous improvement in their sustainability efforts.

Louis Guntrum

All wines are vegan, vegetarian and gluten free. Guntrum employs many sustainable practices but does not have a certification.

Montsarra Cava

Broadbent's only Spanish import, a classic blend of Xarel-lo, Macabeo, and Parelleda, using certified organic grapes.

Sadie Family Wines

Sadie Family Wines follows sustainable practices but is not certified. All wines are vegan, vegetarian, gluten free, and naturally fermented.



Spy Valley



Proudly accredited under the New Zealand Sustainable Winegrowing scheme which promotes economically and environmentally sustainable vineyard management. Wine must be made from 100% certified grapes in winemaking facilities that are independently audited and certified. They continue to monitor, measure, reduce... repeat, producing sustainably crafted wines that capture the unique time and place of every harvest. Spy Valley's ENVOY wines are vegan and vegetarian. Both Spy Valley and ENVOY Chardonnay and Pinot Noir's are all naturally fermented.

Storm Wines



IPW certified sustainable, 100% organically farmed but awaiting certification. All wines are vegan, vegetarian, gluten free, and naturally fermented.

Tyrrell's



Established an Environmental Management System in 2009, designed to operate in accordance with the requirements of the International Standard for Environmental Management, ISO:14,001. All premium 100% Hunter Valley and Heathcote wines are suitable for vegetarians and vegans. All wines are gluten free. Their Hunter Valley Winery and Vineyards are officially certified members of the national Sustainable Winegrowing Australia program.

Vilafonté



All wines are vegan- and vegetarian-friendly. Sustainable practices are employed but no certifications.

Weingut Machherndl





All wines are naturally fermented, and vegan with no fining except protein stabilization & minimal sulphur. Herbicides have not been used since 2008. Certified organic vineyards since 2018.

Weingut Markus Huber



The entire estate was certified organic starting with the 2019 vintage, but they have been farming organically since 2017. The winery is also certified sustainable. All wines are vegan, vegetarian and gluten free. The VISION Grüner Veltliner 2019 is the first 100% organic wine in the Huber portfolio.
